2022 OWB Community Plan Update



In the five years since the original 2016 OWB Community Plan was established much has changed in our neighborhood and beyond. As OWB approached our 5 year anniversary, we wanted to take an opportunity to reconnect with the community to review the ambitious goals set out in the original plan, and identify any emerging or particular priorities where our efforts should be focused in the coming 5 years.

With the input of hundreds of residents through surveys, group discussions, and individual interviews, the 2022 Community Plan Update was completed in late 2021. The update calls for continued efforts to support OWB homeowners, and new work focused on supporting small businesses and waterfront connections, among others. For the past 40 years, VLP has provided necessary supports to local Veterans who are facing challenging transitions. In 2020, VLP assisted 6,208 Veterans with essential services throughout 30 counties in Western and Central Pennsylvania, New York, and Ohio.

Interested in Keeping OWB Clean and Litter-Free?

A new committee has been formed to address the issue of litter in the West Bayfront. Residents took initiative to form a committee to implement solutions to the litter issue after Gannon students demonstrated potential solutions to clean up litter as part of a marketing course. The group considers a number of perspectives, including residential and business related litter.

Overall, the committee's aim will be to reduce litter through education and awareness, targeting outreach and cleanups, and encouraging all residents to help solve the problem. In 2022, the committee plans to conduct an assessment that accurately shows the scale of litter in the West Bayfront neighborhoods, as well as begin coordinating more frequent community cleanups.


