

CASCADE PATH SUN GATE



In early June, a major new artwork is scheduled to be installed at the top of Cascade Path, the walkway that connects Cascade Street to the waterfront. *Sun Gate*, created by artists Tom Ferraro, Ed Grout and Ron Bayuzick, follows the installation of two new murals on Cascade Street last year, developed in collaboration with students from Strong Vincent Middle School as part of the Art Force after school project.

"The lines of the sculpture create movement symbolizing both the waves of the bay and the foliage found along the bluffs. They intersect with the circular shape of the sun shining onto the bay and the OWB neighborhood" -Tom Ferraro, Artist

These works enhance the historic connection between the West Bayfront neighborhoods and the waterfront along Cascade Street.

GOAL: A COVID-FREE OWB!

Two Covid 19 vaccine clinics were held in at the First Presbyterian Church of the Covenant (FPCC) in May/June, resulting in nearly 200 residents getting their vaccines just in time to enjoy the summer. "It is inspiring to see the neighborhood pull together like this to increase Erie's vaccination rate. The church serves as a familiar gathering place for 12-step groups, Sunday Suppers, community events and Gannon student activities... so it seemed a natural place to offer vaccines," said Joseph Kumer of the FPCC.

Free Covid-19 testing continues to be available at the Erie MLK Center, 312 Chestnut St., every Thursday.

LIGHTS ON OWB!

Through *Lights On OWB!* we are working with neighborhood groups and residents to make the West Bayfront neighborhoods more welcoming to residents and visitors. OWB is working with neighborhood associations to identify blocks where new lighting and other improvements will benefit neighbors. Through this project, LED sensor bulbs have been distributed to 238 households throughout the community, making it easier for neighbors to walk in the evening hours.

Improvements at Bayview Park have continued throughout the spring, and we are ready for a great summer season at the park! New swinging benches have been installed at the top of the bluff, perfect for a sunset view. Lighting on the basketball courts now makes it possible for players to shoot hoops in the evening hours.
