Ben Franklin Technology Partners - For 40 Years, Ben Franklin Technology Partners of Central & Northern PA has provided startup funding and business support services to tech-based startups and small manufacturers located in PA.

As an on-going initiative of the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development and funded by the Ben Franklin Technology Development Authority, the Program invests not only in the marketable innovations developed in our service area – many of which come to light from our annual <u>BIG IDEA Contests</u> – but also in business mentoring and support initiatives such as our <u>Transformation Business Services Network</u> and the BF TechCelerator Business Startup Boot Camps.



<u>Creative Entrepreneurial Accelerator Program</u> - Erie Arts and Culture is partnering with the Pennsylvania Council on the Arts to help creative entrepreneurs and their businesses. This entrepreneurial ecosystem encourages an unprecedented level of collaboration between budding entrepreneurs, business students, seasoned business faculty, and consultants in a facility that looks and feels like a major corporate headquarters. This type of collaboration further enhances the delivery of services to entrepreneurs in the ETI community.



<u>ErieMade Business Academy</u> - Free 6-month program teaches business fundamentals for artists and creatives. Receive one-on-one business mentorship with a creative business owner, and access to a monthly cohort meetup with other creative businesses. Find guidance and accountability from those who have been in your shoes, and turn your creative pursuit into something that pushes you forward.

## T.A.P. Grant

T.A.P. Grant - The City T.A.P. Fund is the City of Erie's first ever grant program for workforce development; designed to support and realize several elements of our Mayor's Vision, especially: Excellent Education for Everyone, an Abundance of Family-sustaining Jobs, and ultimately, Erie is a Community of Choice.

Established to provide financial assistance to businesses in any sector support job readiness and training, it also serves to enhance the City of Erie's reputation for innovation and creativity; contribute to a thriving, sustainable business culture; and improve the quality of life for residents of the City of Erie. Funding awards will be granted up to \$2,500 per trainee. Maximum grant award per company, per year is \$5000 (2 trainees per year).



The Northwest Commission - Serves as a regional-based resource for business and economic development as well as community development and planning. Comprised of a team of skilled professionals, the non-profit agency is dedicated to sustaining the economic vitality and growth by offering both free and low-cost services. This is achieved through fostering local, state, and federal partnerships across public and private sector lines.
