Lift Liberty Street Update

OWB is working with Liberty Street residents on improvements to Liberty Street from the bluffs to West 12th Street. Liberty Street is the central north-south corridor through the West Bayfront community, linking West 12th Street to historic Gridley Park to the beautiful views of Presque Isle Bay.

OWB is actively working with 22 property owners on repair projects at their homes, and is coordinating sidewalk repairs at 9 properties. This summer, a National Civilian Community Corps (NCCC) team will help with landscaping and home repairs. Based on responses to a recent survey of residents, we will work with NCCC volunteers on boulevard beautification projects, and are discussing potential traffic calming measures with the City of Erie. This work is generously funded by ECGRA, PNC, and Erie Insurance.





Litter Assessment Continues

In June, Wabtec Intern Volunteers completed a litter assessment of the West Bayfront. Using ArcGIS and QuickCapture, volunteers were easily able to track what types of litter they collected. Over 12,000 pieces of litter were collected and categorized. Using this data, Our West Bayfront can better utilize anti-litter initiatives, such as installing trashcans, messaging campaigns, and cleanup efforts.

Gridley Park Improvements

OWB is working with residents to envision the future of Gridley Park! A draft concept plan for the park based on community input was released earlier this spring for review. The plan, available for review at www.ourwestbayfront.org/Gridley, identifies several improvements to the park including pedestrian safety, places for residents to gather, and additional play areas.

OWB residents identified proposed safety improvements as the first priority for implementation. In the coming weeks, we will be working on finalizing the concept plan while working with the City to identify potential funding sources to make these improvements.
